Lemon Cream Bonbons

- 2 8 oz. packages of cream cheese softened
- 3 tablespoons lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons lemon peel
- 1 teaspoon lemon extract
- 1 cup confectioners' sugar
- 1 pound dark chocolate candy coating, melted
- 4 ounces white candy coating, melted

In a large bowl, beat the cream cheese, lemon juice, extract, and peel. Gradually beat in confectioners' sugar. Cover and freeze for two hours.

Using a small ice cream scoop, drop mixture by 1 inch balls onto waxed paper-lined baking sheets. Cover and freeze for one hour.

Working with a few frozen balls at a time, dip into melted chocolate; allow excess to drip off. Place on waxed paper lined baking sheets. Let stand until set.

Spool the melted candy coating into a heavy duty re-sealable plastic bag. Cut a small hole in the corner of bag; drizzle coating over candies. Store in the refrigerator. Remove from the refrigerator just before serving. Yields about four dozen.

Stitching Tips: To estimate the size of material required to cross stitch, divide the stitch count by the size of the fabric then add 3 inches on both sides. Find the center of the pattern and the center of the fabric and count up to the top. Work from the top down, not the center out. If you want to know more, sign up for class. The more classes you attend, the more you know and the easier it is to stitch.
